
2018 City of Torrance Rose Parade Float Wins Mayor Trophy



2018 Float Rider's Corner—Irene Tsay



Riding the Rose Float was a once in a lifetime experience. Waking up was difficult, but sleeping was even harder. Even though I knew that I had to meet the riders at 4:30, I was unable to sleep, even past the New Year's celebration.

When I got there, it was freezing. We were able to look through the other events in the parade such as the bands and horses.
